
Availability. Download via the internet, please go to the SBEDS web site

Zip File Installation. Open the zip file in your zip utility; extract all files to the directory of your choice. SBEDS uses Visual Basic Macro. Prior to opening SBEDS.XLS the security in Excel must be set to a medium level. This security level will prompt the user on whether to enable macros or not when workbooks containing macros are opened. To set the security level select <Tools><Macro><Security> from the Excel menu. When opening SBEDS, select 'Enable Macros' when prompted. When first opening SBEDS the person logged onto the computer must have administrator privileges so the dll file is properly registered and Registration Key information is properly displayed

Registration Key. The first time you run SBEDS it will bring up a notice that you need a registration key. This registration key is required to run SBEDS. Click <OK>. You will now see an "Enter key" dialog with (this is important) a "Hardware fingerprint", which will be an 8-digit hexadecimal number (XXXX-XXXX).



Requesting your Registration Key. Send your company name, email address, name and the hardware fingerprint to the USACE Protective Design Center to receive your

registration key. Your email address should point to a domain that corresponds with your company and not (hotmail, aol ...). Contact by web access is preferred, but email acceptable in the same format discussed below.

If you choose to email your information it needs to be in the following format:

You will receive by email NAME and Registration KEY inputs from the SBEDS support team. Upon receipt of the NAME and KEY information, enter these fields exactly in the "Enter Key" dialog that SBEDS has displayed. It is easiest to cut and paste to input the data.

You'll need to obtain a new registration key for each computer you install SBEDS on, since the hardware fingerprint is unique to every computer. Any major changes to your computer will change your hardware finger print, this will require you to reapply for a registration key
